With seven years experience and a jaw-dropping 13-year, \$325 million contract under his belt (the richest deal in sports history), it's time the 27-year-old perennial All-Star gift himself. Stanton recently purchased a tri-level contemporary penthouse at Aria on the Bay, an under construction 53-story luxury tower (designed by Arquitectonica and developed by the Melo Group) on downtown Miami's waterfront.

Staton's five-bedroom, seven-and-a-half bathroom residence spans the building's top three stories (the upper deck!) boasting two private elevators, 10-foot-high floor-to-ceiling glass windows and doors, a wrap-around open-air rooftop terrace with private pool and outdoor summer kitchen, and panoramic views of Biscayne Bay, Miami Beach and the city skyline. The residence features über modern interiors, luxury appliances, and designer finishes and fixtures.

Although the sale price was undisclosed, Stanton's unit is likely on the upper range of the \$1.8 million to \$6.6 million asking prices at Aria. Aria's penthouses feature living spaces from 2,600 to 4,800 square feet with 12-foot-deep balconies providing an additional 3,000 square feet. Judging from images, Stanton's residence will offer more than enough living and entertaining room for the 6-foot-6-inch superstar.

"After looking at other buildings with my broker, Ben Moss, Aria on the Bay's downtown location with sweeping views and the developer's attention to detail sold me on this property," said Giancarlo Stanton.



Aria on the Bay is a 53-story Miami tower with 648 luxury residences.

Not that Stanton needs it, but the building's 14th floor amenity deck has two swimming pools, jacuzzi, custom-seated fire pits, barbecue grills and outdoor kitchens. Additional perks include a fitness center, yoga studio, an indoor-outdoor entertainment lounge, a screening room, game room and a library. Aria also features 20,000 square feet of retail, restaurant and commercial space on the ground level.
