## Giancarlo Stanton tours his multimillion triplex penthouse

Giancarlo Stanton — the Miami Marlins superstar who's coveted for 2018 rosters leaguewide — seems set to stay in Miami.

Spies said the player was seen touring his under-construction, multimillion triplex penthouse with his interior design team, as they planned the luxe pad's finishing touches that will be completed next year.

Also with Stanton — who bought the spread at Aria on the Bay back in May — were the building's Melo Group developers Carlos and Martin Melo.

While Stanton could hit 60 or more homers this season and has a long-term, \$325 million deal with the Marlins, reports say the Giants, Cardinals, Rangers and Phillies have all called regarding a trade in the off-season.

However, new Marlins ownership headed by Derek Jeter could make a blockbuster deal to relaunch the team.

Either way, Stanton will have the five-bedroom, --7 1/2-bathroom unit to call home if he sticks around.

Sources were mum on the price, but a similar space is going for a mere \$6 million.
